

# Spooktacular Halloween

Halloween is here and it is going to be *tricky* to trick or treat at a safe distance. Fear not, we have you covered with these simple spooky ideas. Why not throw a small party for 5 and impress the little and not so little ones?

What you will need:

- Tray
- Strings/ribbons/pipe cleaners
- Plastic creepy crawlies
- Plastic skeletons/eyeballs
- Container
- Tweezer

## Spooky web

A magical entangled web filled with creepy crawlies and the spookies! Get them working hard to rescue everything. Lots of fun plus excellent for fine motor exercise too!!!

- 1. Tie ribbons, strings and pipe cleaners onto tray to create a web.
- 2. Place creepy crawlies and body parts on the tray.
- 3. Encourage children to use tweezers to pick up the creepy crawlies and body parts. Try to avoid touching the ribbons, strings, and pipe cleaners.



Don't get entangled in that web!!!



What you will need:

- Gummy worms
- Soda water
- Water
- Transparent container

### Moving worms!

Create your very own family of squiggly, wiggly worms. Watch them squirm and wriggle around the jar.....

- 1. Soak gummy worms in water for an hour and watch it double in size.
- 2. Remove water and leave the gummy worms in the container.
- 3. Pour soda water and the worms will move on its own!



Eeek! Squiggly, wiggling worms!!!

What you will need:

- Plastic gloves
- Plastic creepy crawlies
- Plastic body parts
- Food colouring
- Water

### Freaky hands

This is a great family activity for all ages, you can create your very own spooky decoration and watch it slowly melt away.....

- 1. Place creepy crawlies and body parts inside the plastic glove.
- 2. Fill the plastic glove with water
- 3. Mix the food colouring of choice into the glove.
- 4. Tie the glove up and shake well.
- 5. Place it in the refrigerator overnight.
- 6. Cut the plastic glove and voila! Your very own freaky hands.
- 7. Challenge yourself to melt the hand as fast as possible!



A Halloween decoration sure to keep them spooked!



What you will need:

- Empty bottle
- Warm water
- Dish soap
- 20 % Hydrogen peroxide
- Dry active yeast
- Food colouring
- Tray
- Gloves
- Cup
- Spoon

#### Witch's brew

Dash of bat whiskers, three purple tadpoles, two pinches of ghost dust......bubble, bubble, bubble away......create your very own witch's brew!

- 1. Place the empty bottle on a tray.
- 2. Scoop in 3-5 tablespoons of dish soap.
- 3. Add 3-5 tablespoons of hydrogen peroxide. (Adult supervision is advised. Wear gloves when handling hydrogen peroxide)
- 4. Add some food colouring.
- 5. Take a tablespoon of dry active yeast and add warm water to dilute it in a cup. Stir until all the clumps are gone.
- 6. Pour yeast mixture into the bottle and get ready for an explosive witch's brew!
